2019 Call for Submissions

- Contributing artists can be transplant candidates, recipients and their families, living donors and donor families, transplant staff, local artists and Canadian celebrities – anyone who wants to help support London Health Sciences Centre’s Multi-Organ Transplant Program.
- Any type of media (painting, photography, textiles, carving, glasswork, mixed media, jewellery) is acceptable. Please ensure that your art is ready for hanging or display.
- Please submit your best work as we will only be accepting 50 art pieces for 2019. Artists must electronically submit photos of their artwork for consideration. Several pieces can be submitted for consideration; however, a maximum of one piece per artist will be accepted.
- High quality photo(s) and a brief description (artist name, title, type of media, size of artwork) must be submitted for artwork to be considered. Please email to both Cate Abbott (cate.abbott@lhsc.on.ca) and Tammy Melo (tammy.melo@lhsc.on.ca) by **March 1, 2019**.
- All submitted pieces will be juried by two local artists. Artists with accepted work will be notified, and all artwork must be received by **March 15, 2019**. These deadlines are firm to allow time for art to be photographed for the auction site.
- Accepted art can be sent by courier or delivered in person. Further details will be provided to all accepted artists.
- For professional artists, a charitable donation tax receipt can be issued for artwork if there is a letter of appraisal from an independent retailer verifying the value *or* if there is a receipt of purchase to clearly indicate the fair market value.
- For non-professional artists, only the value of the materials used to make the art piece is eligible for a charitable donation tax receipt. Please keep your receipts, and note that time cannot be factored in the value.
- Accepted art will be displayed at Art with Panache (www.artwithpanache.ca; 140 Fullarton St., London) from April 23-29, 2019, then displayed at the London Music Hall during the evening’s event on Tuesday, April 30.
- For the duration of the show, each art piece will be sold via an online auction (<https://newcanvasoflife.ca>). **The online auction will run April 23-April 30, 2019.**
